Togo 2025 Trip Overview

AFF expeditions to Togo are structured to provide a life-changing experience combining spiritual growth, cultural immersion, and meaningful service projects. Each expedition includes exposure to various ministry programs, infrastructure development projects, community engagement activities, and spiritual discipleship opportunities. Our expeditions typically accommodate 10 - 12 AFF Team members working alongside local staff and community partners.

Travel arrangements require volunteers to book and pay for their own airfare to Lome Airport. AFF recommends booking flights 2-6 months in advance for optimal pricing and availability.

Meals are provided throughout the expedition, featuring a blend of local cuisine and familiar dishes. Bottled water is always available, and participants are encouraged to bring preferred snacks between meals.

Day-by-Day Schedule

Tuesday, April 22: Arrival Day

Arrival at Lome Airport and transfer to hotel accommodation. Welcome orientation with AFF team leaders, followed by dinner and evening prayer session. Early rest is recommended for the busy days ahead.

Wednesday, April 23: Transition to Ministry Base

Begin the day with breakfast, then depart for Wahala ministry base. Complete installation and accommodation setup. Welcome dinner with AFF team, followed by planning session for upcoming activities and evening prayer time.

Thursday, April 24: Community Engagement

Morning begins with breakfast, followed by official visits to local government leaders (Wahala Mayor & Kekeoude village King) in Wahala. Visit Kekeoude village and participate in well project installation. Lunch break, then meet with Community Base Management Team (CBM) including pastor for 4-1-1 Training. Return to the hotel for dinner and retrospective session, concluding with evening prayers.

Friday, April 25: Ministry Training Day

Start day with breakfast and The Four Fields Model Training. Depart for Kekeoude for VBS Day 1 activities. Lunch break, followed by parallel ministry sessions: women's ministry (4-1-1 training), men's ministry (4-1-1 training), and WASH Training. Visit local tailor for cultural attire preparation. Return to hotel for dinner, retrospective, and evening prayers.

Saturday, April 26: Village Ministry

Begin with breakfast and continued Four Fields Model Training. Depart for Kekeoude for VBS Day 2 activities. Lunch break, followed by cultural gathering featuring dance, drama, and Bible study. Organize soccer game with local youth. Conduct training session with CBM team. Return to the hotel for dinner, debrief, and evening prayers.

Sunday, April 27: Spiritual Focus

Morning church service followed by lunch. Afternoon dedicated to team building activities and games. Personal reflection time available. The evening features dinner, debrief, and planning session for next day's activities, concluding with group prayers.

Monday, April 28: Outreach Activities

Breakfast meeting. Alert Kekeoude village school director for upcoming visit (Wed). Travel to Betoe community, visit **Esther family** and engage with residents around water projects. Return to the hotel for dinner and evening prayers.

Tuesday, April 29: Infrastructure Development

Following breakfast, visit Barrage Nangbeto dam project. Travel to Kekeoude village, arriving in time for lunch. The afternoon session focuses on The Four Fields Model Training. Visit tailor for custom made Togo outfit. Dinner and debrief conclude the day with evening prayers.

Wednesday, April 30: School Ministry

Begin with breakfast, then conduct a school visitation program. Participate in latrine construction project and water well drilling activities. Lunch break followed by Kid Ministry session. Parallel afternoon sessions include women's ministry and men's ministry programs. Dinner and debrief conclude the day with evening prayers.

Thursday, May 1: Cultural Exchange

Morning starts with family photo opportunity at hotel, followed by 4-1-1 training session with pastor and community leaders. Take village family photos, then enjoy lunch together. Visit local farm and participate in cultural gathering featuring dance, drama, and Bible study. Implement WASH Program initiatives. Evening concludes with dinner, debrief, and prayers.

Friday, May 2: Project Dedication

Breakfast precedes the dedication ceremony for newly constructed well, honoring donors who contributed \$1000+. Return to Lome, rest period, and personal time. The evening features dinner and prayer sessions.

Saturday, May 3: Spiritual Growth Day

Morning begins with devotional study ("Celebration of Discipline") and breakfast. Visit Lome Market for cultural immersion, followed by beach time. Evening devotional study continues, concluding with dinner and prayers.

Sunday, May 4: Reflection Day

Morning devotional study ("Celebration of Discipline") followed by beach activities and tourism opportunities. The evening concludes with dinner and final group prayers.

Monday, May 5: Departure Day

The final morning includes breakfast and laundry. Depending on flight departure times, you will enjoy lunch at noon and depart your place of lodging for the airport to return home.
